Asthma and Allergies

The school takes the wellbeing of our pupils very seriously and this includes putting in place arrangements to support children with medical needs. We are writing to you to find out if there is any medical information we need to know, particularly regarding asthma and allergies.

Asthma is a condition that affects 1 in 7 children meaning approximately 70 children in our school may be suffering from the condition. **If your child has asthma, even if you think we already know about it, please complete the form below.**

If your child requires an asthma inhaler in school it is important that this is brought in every day. Many GPs will provide a separate prescription for an inhaler to be kept in school. Inhalers should not be kept in school bags and must be given to the class teacher who will ensure they are safely stored and easily accessible if required.

Please also complete the form below to make us aware of any allergies or intolerances your child suffers from. If there are food groups that they need to avoid, please provide medical evidence of the allergy or intolerance to Mrs. Baker so that a form can be completed for the kitchen.
