Hunstile Farm Trip

Welcome back after the long summer break. We hope you and the children are well rested and ready to embark on the busy term ahead.

Our first topic of the year is "Food Glorious Food". In science we will be looking at where our food comes from and what we mean by a healthy diet. In numeracy we will be working out what skills we need to learn set up a 'pop-up' restaurant, as well as doing some cooking. In literacy we will be reading and working on the books, 'The Enormous Turnip' and 'Grace and Family'.

On our first school trip, we will be visiting an organic farm in Bridgwater. The children will be able to see all the harvested crops, work on the vegetable plots and spend time with the farm animals.
