E-SAFETY FOCUS Is your family cyber secure?



It might not seem like something your family needs to worry about, but even young children can fall victim to cybercrime.....

Clickjacking:

Fraudsters disguise links that download malware onto your device or steal personal information. The links are often made to look like something innocent and tempting such as a funny video or an offer. This type of cyber-attack is common on social media. Warn your child to be careful what they click and to ask if they are unsure. Always lookout for anything suspicious.

Identity Theft:

Make sure your child knows not to give out personal information online. Never share passwords or any details that would help answer security questions on their account or profile i.e. mother's maiden name, name of first pet, postcode etc.

Viruses & Malware:

Talk to your child about the risks of viruses. Opening an infected attachment or visiting a corrupt website could download harmful files onto your device that could lead to fraud, data being lost or your device being made unusable. Make sure antivirus software is installed and regularly updated.

Passwords:

Choose passwords that are impossible to guess and don't use the same password for more than one account. The Home Office's Cyber Streetwise campaign suggests the strongest password consists of three random words.


