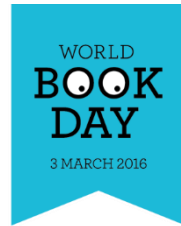
TODAY IS THE LAST DAY OF TERM

Tips for keeping children safe online:

- ➔ Create boundaries and rules for the amount of time your child can spend on the computer, games consoles or tablet.
- ➔ Compile a list of websites your child is allowed to visit and make sure they know why some websites are safer than others.
- ➔ Discuss online privacy with your child and talk about information they shouldn't share online.
- ➔ Choose an appropriate homepage on your family computer or tablet.
