AWARD FOR EXCEPTIONAL 2015 RESULTS

We have been nationally recognised for our exceptional 2015 performance by the Schools, Students and Teachers network (SSAT).

Educational Outcomes data analysis from SSAT has shown that Bournville Primary has enabled children to make progress in Reading, Writing and Maths which is significantly higher than the national average at Key Stage 2, and is among the top 10% across all schools nationally.

E-SAFETY FOCUS



5 tips for staying safe in online multiplayer games:

-  Encourage your child to use a nickname and not their real name when playing online.
-  Make sure they know not to share personal information that could identify them, like their school, address or phone number.
-  If you allow your child to use the voice chat function on their console, remind them that the people they talk to are still strangers, and to be cautious.
-  If someone says or does something online that makes your child uncomfortable, make sure they know they can report this.
-  If in doubt, keep your child's online multiplayer experience to real-life friends only. You can oversee their friends list, restrict their contacts through the console's parental controls, and even disable multiplayer entirely.
