TODAY IS THE DEADLINE FOR RECEPTION YEAR APPLICATIONS

If you have a child due to start school in Reception year in September 2016, **your application for your child's school place has to be with North Somerset School Admissions by 23:59 today (Friday 15th January)**. You can apply online www.n-somerset.gov.uk/Education/Schools/Admissions
