



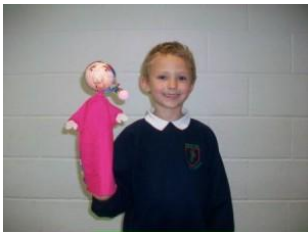

MP JOHN PENROSE VISITS BREAKFAST CLUB

MP John Penrose visited our Breakfast Club this morning along with a representative from Kellogg's. As part of the Kellogg's 'Help give a child a breakfast' campaign we were awarded a grant worth £450 to help fund the school's breakfast club.

Bournville Primary School is one of 500 schools from across the country to receive a grant after research by Kellogg's revealed that one in eight breakfast clubs have been forced to close because of budget cuts.

Kellogg's is donating £230,000 in total through the campaign which will provide one million breakfasts by the end of 2012.
