YEAR 2 PARENT MEETING REMINDER

A reminder that we are holding a meeting on **Wednesday 1st July 2:30pm** for parents of Year 2 children moving to Year 3 (KS2) in September. This meeting will give you the opportunity to meet your child's new class teacher and teams and to find out about what happens in your child's new key stage.

MOVE UP DAY

'Move Up' day is Tuesday 30th June. Year groups (Nursery – Year 5) will visit their new classes and spend time with their new teacher. Parents will have an opportunity to visit their child's new classroom and meet their new teacher at the end of the school day.

At the end of the school day on 'Move up' day (Tuesday 30th June) parents will collect their child from their new classroom and will then have the opportunity to meet their child's new teacher.

SEPTEMBER NURSERY SPACES

We currently have some places remaining in our 2+ nursery. If you require a nursery place from September please call in to the school office and complete an admissions form as soon as possible to secure a place.

If you're in receipt of certain benefits and have a household income of below £16,190 you could **receive funding for 15 hours a week for your 2 year-old child to attend nursery**.
