## SEPTEMBER NURSERY SPACES

**REGISTER NOW**

**You can apply now for September nursery spaces.** Children can join our 2+ nursery the term following their 2<sup>nd</sup> birthday. If you require a nursery place from September please call in to the school office now and complete an admissions form to secure a place.

If you're in receipt of certain benefits and have a household income of below £16,190 you could **receive funding for 15 hours a week for your 2 year-old child to attend nursery.** Call in to the school office and we can help you complete the necessary forms and send them off to North Somerset for you. If you would like to arrange a visit to the nursery or require further information please do come and see us.

## BUILDING AT BOURNVILLE

As you will have noticed the conversion of the old caretaker's house is quite something. The internal works will be completed over half term and our community rooms will be relocated to the BEACH (**Bournville Education And Community Hub**) by the time we return. Lyn Winter and the XTND team are already housed in the offices on the upper floor along with our teaching school.

We now have 3 rooms for our community and teaching school work.

**"The Bay"** is the big room that has been built at the back of the building; it can accommodate over 30 people, being about five times the size of our old community room.

**"The Cove"** is a meeting room for groups of up to 10.

**"The Jetty"** is a lounge where 4 or 5 people can meet and chat.

The BEACH is a great resource for us to support our parents, children and community. Look out for upcoming events @ The BEACH.

During half term the community ICT suite in the school building will be converted into two learning spaces along with the current community room greatly enhancing our teaching provision for children.
