Our school uniform was designed and chosen by our children and parents in 2008. It promotes a sense of pride in the school, it creates a feeling of community and belonging, is practical, smart, identifies children with the school, and promotes equality with their peers.

Our uniform is a navy blue sweatshirt/cardigan/jumper, white shirt/polo shirt/blouse and grey/black trousers/shorts/skirt/dress (in the summer navy blue and white check dresses can be worn). Navy Blue Sweatshirts can be purchased in any supermarket, there is no requirement that garments should have the BPS badge on them. However, the school has navy blue sweatshirts with the school logo available to purchase from £7.50 and cardigans from £8.50. These are available from the School Office.

It is important that children are dressed suitably for school. Jeans, casual clothes, hoodies and fashion shoes are not suitable as school wear, we ask parents to ensure that children adhere to our uniform dress code.

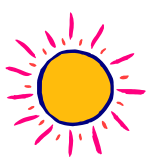
YOUR LOCAL CHARITY
