

Performance Data of Those in Receipt of Pupil Premium Funding 2015-16

Children in receipt of Pupil Premium attending our school make significantly better progress than those nationally and locally, because of this progress these children close attainment gaps between children who do not receive pupil premium.

The information in this section shows the level of progress for year groups 1-6, compared to expected progress. It also details the percentage of those children who are exceeding expected progress rates.

The year 6 data compares attainment and progress against **national data**. This data shows how well children in our school achieve over time, and how they are making significantly better progress than other children nationally and locally. This ensures that, during their time with us, children entitled to pupil premium close the gap and attain at levels exceeding those expected and achieved both nationally and locally.
